About RMHCPA Poster Presentations

The Rocky Mountain Humanistic Counseling and Psychological Association (RMHCPA) encourages students and professionals to submit poster proposals. For our 2020 virtual/online conference, posters will be conducted online. We encourage various types of posters, including:

1. Original Research
2. Theory Development
3. Critical Literature Reviews
4. Case Conceptualizations
5. Proposed Methods for Conducting Original Research

Technical Information

For our virtual conference, posters will be presented online. This will entail:

1. PDF of the poster (Required; recommended size is 36" x 48"). See recommended resources on the next page.
2. Short video or audio recording no longer than 10-minutes discussing the highlights of the poster (strongly encouraged)
3. A brief 3-5 page summary of the poster (optional)
4. Availability for responding to comments about the poster (required)

Posters and supplemental materials must be uploaded October 23, 2020. Poster presenters should be registered for the conference by October 23 as well.

Outstanding Student Poster Award

RMHCPA offers an undergraduate poster award and a graduate student poster award for outstanding poster presentations (pending sufficient submissions). Recipients of these awards will be announced at the RMHCPA Conference. Recipients will receive an Outstanding Student Poster Award Certificate and \$50 cash prize.
